Build Your Dream Home!

Well, maybe not *your* dream home, but probably a dream home for your child! Follow these simple directions for a super easy

"gingerbread" house that's sure to spark holiday cheer:

You'll Need:

- 8-10 graham crackers
- small, empty milk carton (think school cafeteria-size)
- plate or tray for the 'foundation'
- white frosting (it will be easier to use in a tube if you have one)
- assorted candy for decoration

Make a base for the carton to sit on using your plate or tray and some white frosting. Once the carton is in place, frost the sides and top and attach the graham crackers to form a house. You can choose to have a flat roof (one cracker) or a pitched roof (two leaning crackers). Then use small amounts of frosting to stick your assorted candies on the home. Add some extra 'snow' with any leftover white frosting, and come up with creative add-ons like trees, people, etc. Have fun!
